

GCSD SPECTATOR GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

General Guidelines:

- All staff, spectators and other auxiliary groups should stay home if they **have** a fever or feel sick.
- All staff, spectators, and anyone associated with an auxiliary group must wear a face covering at all times.
- All spectators and anyone associated with an auxiliary group must maintain 6 feet social distancing at all times during the event. (Consideration will be given to families from the same household).
- Congregating in groups inside a venue is not allowed.
- Megaphones and any other similar artificial noisemakers that could potentially spread respiratory droplets are prohibited for use by spectators.
- Spectators, including parents, will not be allowed to visit with any athlete in the facility once the contest is over to prevent congregating and large group gathering.
- Spectators must remain in spectator seating areas at all times.
- Sidelines should be limited to essential personnel only.
- Gathering of teams post-game should not be allowed.

Admission/Parking:

- Ticket windows and ticket gates will be open one hour before scheduled start time of varsity contests and will open 30 minutes prior to scheduled start time of sub varsity contests.
- Gathering of crowds for tailgating or other social interactions is prohibited.
- Upon exiting the vehicle, all persons must put on their face covering.
- Capacity is limited to accommodate social distancing (6 feet).
- Athletes and Coaches who are not involved in a live contest are considered a spectator.
- Exact change should be used if possible to prevent money from having to be exchanged.

CLEAR BAG ENTRY PROCEDURE

The GCSD will implement a Clear Bag Entry Procedure at sporting events beginning with the Fall 2020 season. The procedure will be mandatory for the 2020-21 school year.

Approved bags include the following:

- Clear plastic or vinyl bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One gallon plastic freezer bag
- Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" – with or without a handle or strap
- Medically necessary items (after proper screening)
- Diaper bags (infant/toddler must be attending – after proper screening)

Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to:

- Backpacks
- Fanny packs
- Cinch/Drawstring bags
- Briefcases
- Purses larger than a clutch bag
- Computer/camera bags
- Luggage of any kind

Other prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Firearms/knives/concealable weapons
- Mace/pepper spray
- Coolers
- Alcoholic beverages
- Laser lights/laser pointers/strobe lights
- Fireworks/explosives
- Artificial noisemakers
- Inflatables (beach balls, etc...)
